If there are any atypical features or concern about these patients, please discuss with a neuro-ophthalmologist on-site (Miss Alvarez or Mr Nassr).

If there are not around, you can always call Queen Elizabeth Hospital to ask for neuro-ophthalmologist fellow for advice during working hours on the weekdays.

Please treat these patients like how we would manage patients with GCA or acute angle closure glaucoma because they are high risk of going blind and only have a small window of opportunity of rescuing their vision especially in the atypical patients.
